To all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas George Battenfeld of Mercer County Pennsylvania has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the land office at Bucyrus whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said George Battenfeld according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North half of the North East quarter of Section twenty eight in Township one North of Range thirteen in the District of Lands subject to sale at Bucyrus, Ohio containing Eighty Acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said George Battenfeld. NOW KNOW YE That the United States of America in consideration of the Premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in case made and provided Have Given And Granted and by these presents Do Give And Grant unto the said George Battenfeld and to his heirs the said tract above described: To Have And To Hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said George Battenfeld and to his heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony whereof I Andrew Jackson President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made. Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the fourteenth day of December in the

year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty five - and of the Independence of the United States the sixtieth - By the President Andrew Jackson, By A. J. Donelson - Secy - Ethan A. Brown, Commissioner of the General Land Office - This Patent was filed for Record December 10th 1847 - and Recorded December 11th, 1847.
